Chairman Becker opened the meeting at 9:00 a.m. One item was added to the agenda for November 7, 2022: Cereal Malt Beverage (CMB) Notice to Township, Canton. Commissioner Kueser made a motion to approve the agenda as amended. Commissioner O'Dell seconded. **All voted aye.**

During Public Input at 9:00 a.m., Sheriff Jerry Montagne presented current jail counts, weekly arrests, monthly civil process statistics, and department activities. Sheriff Montagne also introduced Tammy McCune, American Red Cross Representative, who presented the Annual Battle of the Badges Blood Drive 1st Place Trophy to Sheriff Montagne on behalf of McPherson County/City law enforcement.

Commissioner Kueser made a motion to approve the minutes for October 31, 2022 as corrected. Commissioner O'Dell seconded. **All voted aye.**

At 9:10 a.m., Bill Gately, McPherson Hospital Board Representative; and Aaron Herbel, Moundridge Hospital Administrator, joined the meeting for discussion, and to update Commissioners on recent projects, current financial status, and operational needs. A sales tax funding question is set to be on the Fall 2023 ballot, which if passed, will distribute tax dollars among the three County Hospitals.
